

Mentor Responsibilities and Grades

Journal/weekly journal (30 pts/30% or you're overall grade): Make notes in your journal everyday on how things went during class, record the following: suggestions/ideas, what went well and what did not go well. On the internet make a journal entry to me once a week summarizing your daily notes, don't forget to include any concerns/suggestion you have. Make your weekly journal entry at www.mrspritchard.com, click on the Mentor link then the journal link.

Project (100 pts/20% of your overall grade): Due the last day of term 3

Watch a movie that has a peer/mentor relationship. Write a 1-2 page paper about the influence the mentor had on the peer and how you can apply this to the classroom.

Daily Class Points (30pts daily/50% of your overall grade):

Mentors will be assessed on their participation in class; which is worth 30 points every class.

You will lose points for not sitting by your group, for socializing with the students or other mentors, for reading or doing homework for another class, or anything else that isn't appropriate.

You receive full points for modeling good learning/classroom habits, helping students, cooperating with me, staying engaged and having good attitudes.

Classroom expectations:

- Take notes,
- Help students,
- Help maintain a positive learning environment,
- Model note taking skills,
- Help students stay organized,
- Treat students fairly.

Tickets (limit 3 per class period):

1-ticket for completed assignments (I will have a daily homework drawing most class periods)

0, 1, or 2 of good class behavior; use them as a "carrot" to encourage positive behavior the entire class.
